ONE OF 6 SMOKEJUMPERS STATIONED HERE IN 1955 TO MOVE & RECONSTRUCT THE TWO EXISTING CABINS FROM BEAR CREEK STATION.

USING A REVERSABLE PLOW & HAND TOOLS, WE WIDENED EXISTING TRAIL TO BEAR CREEK SO THAT A TRACTOR & WAGON COULD HAUL A FEW LOGS AT A TIME BACK TO SHEARER FOR RECONSTRUCTION.

SNAKES WERE CUT NEW (1955) & HARDWOOD FLOORS WERE SALVAGED IN PIECES FROM BEAR CREEK CABINS.
