Mr. METCALF introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs

---

## A BILL

To designate certain lands as wilderness.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That, in accordance with section 3 (b) of the Wilderness  
4       Act (78 Stat. 890; 16 U.S.C. 1132 (b) ), there are hereby  
5       designated as wilderness certain lands in the Bitterroot and  
6       Nez Perce National Forests, Idaho, which comprise approxi-  
7       mately two hundred and fifty thousand acres as depicted  
8       on a map entitled "Upper Selway Wilderness—Proposed,"  
9       dated December 1965, which shall be known as the "Upper  
10      Selway Wilderness."

11      SEC. 2. As soon as practicable after this Act takes effect-

1 the Secretary of Agriculture shall file a map and a legal  
2 description of this wilderness area with the Interior and In-  
3 sular Affairs Committees of the United States Senate and  
4 the House of Representatives, and such description shall have  
5 the same force and effect as if included in this Act: *Pro-*  
6 *vided, however,* That correction of clerical and typographical  
7 errors in such legal description and map may be made.

8       SEC. 3. The wilderness area designated by this Act shall  
9 be administered by the Secretary of Agriculture in accord-  
10 ance with the provisions of the Wilderness Act governing  
11 areas designated by that Act as wilderness areas, except that  
12 any reference in such provisions to the effective date of the  
13 Wilderness Act shall be deemed to be a reference to the  
14 effective date of this Act.
